A Sample 8 Day Itinerary

Day 1 - Arrive in Israel. Travel to Nazareth

Day 2 - Breakfast with leaders of various Christian denominations in the city, Tour the Church of the Annunciation, the Old City of Nazareth, Nazareth Village and Mt. Tabor

Day 3 - Explore Beit She'an then retrace the footsteps of Jesus in Galilee by bike, foot, or bus. Dinner with a Christian family.

Day 4 - Visit Um al Fahm (largest Muslim city in Israel), Caesaria and then to Tel Aviv. Optional theater, ballet etc in Tel Aviv.

Day 5 - Visit Jaffa, afternoon at the beach. Dinner at a beachside restaurant.

Day 6 - Tour of the old city of Jerusalem. Walk the Via Dolorosa, Mt. of Olives and more. Tour of Abu Tor, a mixed neighborhood in Jerusalem. Dinner with leaders of local NGO's representing Christian, Jewish, and Muslim interests.

Day 7 - Visit to Bethlehem and the Church of the Nativity and possibly Jericho.

Day 8 - Free Morning in Jerusalem. Return to airport in afternoon for flight home.
